**Popular Kiwanis golf tournament brings 2003 funds  
raised for local non-profits to more than \$50,000**

The annual San Ramon Valley Kiwanis Club golf tournament was held on April 14 at the Round Hill Country Club in Alamo with near sold out attendance. With almost \$6,000 raised on the day of the tournament itself, sponsorships solicited from businesses prior to the event, which include sponsorship of the annual Kiwanis Danville Fourth of July Parade, totaled more than \$47,000 bringing the 2003 Kiwanis fundraising to more than \$53,000. The Kiwanis Club uses funds raised through the golf tournament and parade to provide annual grants to worthwhile local non-profit organizations, area schools and scholarships for students from the three local high schools.

While no one won the 2003 Volvo provided by the tournament's main sponsor, Lawrence Volvo of Walnut Creek, for a hole in one, the 132 participants enjoyed the day and participated in various golf contests and raffles. With the increasing popularity of the annual event, chairman David Colello advised local golfers to mark their 2004 calendars for April 19, the date of the next tournament as the event returns to its traditional timing of the first Monday following Tax Day.
