**Openings still available for
Kiwanis Golf tournament April 14**

ALAMO-The annual Kiwanis Club of San Ramon Valley Invitational Golf Tournament presented by Lawrence Volvo April 14 at Alamo's Round Hill Country Club has openings for a few additional golfers. Traditionally the first major golf tournament of the spring/summer season, the Kiwanis event usually sells out months in advance, according to tournament chair David Colello of Danville. "It must be the uncertain times," Colello said, adding that it presented an opportunity for golfers who had not previously participated in the 30-year old tournament to do so.

The tournament is formatted for golfers of all skill levels and is attended by civic and business leaders from throughout the San Ramon Valley. Various contests enliven the afternoon including hole-in-one prizes of a 2003 Volvo sedan courtesy of Lawrence Volvo of Walnut Creek and a Rolex watch courtesy of Heller Jewelers of San Ramon. Other tournament prizes are awarded for accurate drive, long drive and closest to the pin, as well as winning individuals and foursomes in each format.

A barbecue lunch precedes the noon shotgun start and the tournament is followed by a buffet dinner, awards and raffle. The \$1,000 grand raffle prize is courtesy of Goldstein-Enright Accountancy.
