BUTTON WINNER AND CONTEST FOR THE 2004 DANVILLE 4<sup>th</sup> OF JULY PARADE**

DANVILLE – The theme of the 2004 Danville 4th of July Parade, presented by Heller Jewelers, is “HOME OF THE BRAVE.” The Kiwanis Club of San Ramon Valley would like to extend a congratulations to our 2004 winning artist, Jeffrey Langewisch! Jeffrey is an 18-year-old student at California High School in Danville, who created the winning artwork for this year’s button.

In 2002, the Kiwanis Club of the San Ramon Valley started a new tradition—a contest to create an annual 4th of July Parade Commemorative Button. Each year local artists under the age of 20, on or before July 4th, are encouraged to participate by submitting artwork for the button.

The Commemorative Buttons are sold prior to the parade for \$2 each at the Bank of Walnut Creek in Danville at 680 Hartz Avenue, or the Bank of Walnut Creek in San Ramon, at 3130 Crow Canyon Road. They can also be purchased at the parade for \$3 each. All proceeds from Commemorative Button sales benefit local charities.

This year, we have a special treat. Please join us for the “Home of the Brave Game,” and WIN a \$100 Government Bond, courtesy of Bank of Walnut Creek! Here’s how it works — the 2004 commemorative button contains four symbols of the parade theme “Home of the Brave.” Figure out the words associated with the four symbols. All correct entries will be entered into a drawing to be held July 8th. One winner will be drawn. Entries must contain the words, your name, address and telephone number.
